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

The symbol of Madrid is the bear and the strawberry tree.

It is said that Madrid was founded in the 9th century by the emir Mohamed I of Córdoba, who established a fortress in the area.

At that time, the area was covered in forests and was inhabited by bears and abundant strawberry trees, which are native trees of the region.

In addition to its historical significance, the bear and the strawberry tree also represent the welcoming and traditional spirit of Madrid.

The image of the bear and the strawberry tree can be found in many places in the city, on the city's coat of arms, on traffic signs and on the logo of various Madrid institutions.

WALKING TOUR

Retiro Park

Covering over 125 hectares and comprising more than 15,000 trees, El Retiro Park, recently named a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is a green oasis in the heart of the city. In it you'll find all kinds of interesting monuments and gardens, including the Jardín de Vivaces, the Jardines de Cecilio Rodríguez (Andalusian-inspired classic gardens), Architect Herrero Palacios Gardens, the Rosaleda Rose Garden and the French Parterre, where you can find a Mexican conifer nearly 400 years old, and believed to be Madrid's oldest tree.

In addition being considered the city's green lungs, it is also a popular spot among Madrileños who like to go there for a stroll, visit an exhibition or take the kids to a puppet show. The park is home to a large artificial lake, where you can rent a rowing boat or stroll by the Velázquez's Palace and the Glass Palace which are both currently used as exhibition halls by the Reina Sofía Museum. The latter is a beautiful glass pavilion built in 1887 to house exotic plants for an exhibition on the Philippines. It is one the finest examples of castiron architecture in Spain.

The Reina Sofía Museum is famous for its extensive collection of modern and contemporary art. It houses works by prominent Spanish artists such as Salvador Dalí, precursor of Spanish surrealism, Joan Miró, characterized by abstract and symbolic elements, or the most international of our painters, Pablo Picasso.

You will undoubtedly be surprised to see one of his iconic paintings, such as "Guernica", a masterpiece

that depicts the horrors of the Spanish Civil War. These three artists played an important role in shaping the art landscape of the 20th century.

At the end of the visit, we will enjoy a private sightseeing tour in open-top buses, visiting the most emblematic places in Madrid. During the visit you will be able to listen to the comments of each place in several languages. We will finish at the hotel.

Time for rest, before going to the closing dinner to enjoy Spanish cuisine and flamenco.




VISIT Toledo

A visit to Toledo is a journey back in time, it is known for its rich heritage and architectural wonders.

Toledo is often referred to as the "Imperial City" or the "City of the Three Cultures" due to its history and the coexistence of Christians, Muslims and Jews throughout the centuries. The city has been inhabited since Roman times and was the capital of the Visigothic kingdom before becoming an important cultural and religious center during the Middle Ages. The city is home to many places of interest; his majestic Gothic Cathedral, the synagogue of Santa María la Blanca, an example of Mudejar architecture and one of the oldest synagogues in Europe, the Gothic Monastery of San Juan de los Reyes, built by the Catholic Kings or the Puerta del Sol, which offers impressive views of its medieval walls. We cannot forget the presence of El Greco who lived and worked in the city during the 16th century.



VISIT

Palacio Real de Madrid

A visit to the Royal Palace of Madrid is a must for anyone interested in the history and culture of Spain. It is the official residence of the Spanish royal family. Although it is no longer his permanent residence, it is used for state ceremonies and official functions. The palace was originally built in the 18th century and stands on the site of the old Alcázar, a medieval fortress. The Royal Palace is a magnificent architectural masterpiece displaying a mix of baroque and classical styles. During your visit, you can explore various rooms and areas of the Royal Palace. Some of the highlights include the Throne Room, the Banquet Hall, the Royal Pharmacy, and the Royal Armory, which displays an impressive collection of

arms and armor. The Royal Palace is surrounded by the beautiful Sabatini Gardens, named after the Italian architect Francesco Sabatini. From the palace and gardens you can also enjoy panoramic views of the city of Madrid.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

WEATHER

In October, Madrid experiences a transition from hot summer weather to autumn temperatures that tend to be nice and mild. During the day, between 16°C (61°F) and 22°C (72°F). Mornings and evenings can be cooler. It is advisable to pack both light clothing and some layers for the cooler hours.

October is a month in which the probability of rain increases in Madrid. Some precipitation can occur, but usually it is not very abundant.

PASSPORT AND VISA

Citizens of the EU or the Schengen area do not need a visa to enter Spain and can enter with a valid passport or ID. Non-EU citizens need a valid passport and should check if they require a visa to enter Spain. We recommend visiting the website of the Spanish embassy in your country to confirm this point.

EURO CURRENCY (€)

Cash is available 24 hours a day at ATMs with EC card or international credit card. All major credit cards are generally accepted, though often only for a certain minimum amount. It is advisable to have some cash with you.

TIME ZONE

Central European Summer Time (CEST): UTC+2.

ELECTRICITY

230V / 50Hz, plug type C This socket also works with plug E, F, H and K.

EMERGENCY NUMBERS

112 is the single emergency telephone number for the entire European Union. Any emergency can be communicated, whether in the field of aid and rescue, health, traffic and security.

CODE TO DIAL

Telephone code of Spain: 0034 or +34.

DRINKING WATER

There is drinkable water from the taps.

HEALTH

No particular health risks. Be sure to get travel insurance that includes coverage for medical evacuation and hospital stays.

SECURITY

Petty crime, such as pickpocketing and bag snatching, occurs as in all large cities. Make sure your belongings, including your passport and travel documents, are safe at all times. Violent crime is rare.

On the street, you can hail a free taxi by raising your arm or at official ranks throughout the city. A taxi is free if it has a green roof light on and displays the FREE sign out front. Your hotel reception will also be happy to call a taxi for you.

There are two frequently used and very safe applications: UBER and CABIFY.

FROM AND TO MADRID AIRPORT

At the airport you will find taxis as soon as you go out on the street after picking up your luggage. Official taxis are white with a red cross on the door.

The normal one-way price from the airport to the hotel is currently around \in 40.


